Korean Tigers Demonstration Team to Perform in Raymore

Raymore, MO (August 2, 2010) – On Saturday, August 7, 2010 at 2:00 p.m. Pak's Academy of Raymore is hosting a performance by the Korean Tigers Demonstration Team, an elite group of black belt martial arts experts from South Korea. The performance is part of the Tigers' 2010 USA Tour. "This is an amazing opportunity for our Tae Kwon Do students and the community as a whole," said Master Se Chun Pak, owner of Pak's Academy and a former member of the Korean Tigers. "The Korean Tigers are highly skilled and put on a high-energy, technically amazing show."
